

Commodores Corner - December 2025


Holiday greetings Yacht Club Mateys!

Now for my "Message in a Bottle":

Hey mariners, can you guess what this is?

Semaphore flag signals are commonly used for communication at sea, and are still in use by the U.S. Navy today.

The modern peace sign originates from flag semaphore letters "N" (2 flags down at 45 degree angle) and "D" (1 flag straight up and 1 flag straight down) and first used for the British Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament in 1958.



Soon after in the 1960s it was adopted by the anti-war movement in the U.S. and has become a worldwide symbol for peace and harmony.
